



Full-Time Workers Earning Below the Poverty Level





Full-Time Workers With Earnings Below Poverty Level





Eligible Public and Private Sector Workers Covered by a Collective Bargaining Agreement 1992



Elections in Which Workers Vote for Representation in the Private and Public Sectors 1991 - 1992




Public and Private Sector Workers Belonging to Labor Unions




Representation Election Campaigns in Which Workers Are Unlawfully Discharged


