MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT


This Memorandum of Agreement is entered into by and between the Erie 2-Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES ("BOCES"), and the Administrative Management Association ("Association"), hereinafter, the parties.

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement between the parties as stipulated in section 5.1, covered the period July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2006 and


WHEREAS, the association requested to extend the terms and conditions of that collective bargaining agreement through June 30, 2007 to include a salary increase only.

ACCORDINGLY, upon ratification by the board of education, the BOCES and the Association agree to extend the terms and conditions of the above referenced collective bargaining agreement for the period effective July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 with a three percent (3%) salary increase, effective July 1, 2006, to be applied to the 2005-06 base salaries of the association membership.
