AGREEMENT OF THE AMALGAMATED MEATCUTTERS AND BUTCHER WORKMEN OF N.A., A.F.L. LOCAL NO. 587—SANTA MONICA BAY DISTRICT, WEST LOS ANGELES, WESTWOOD VILLAGE, PALMS, CULVER CITY, EL SEGUNDO, MANHATTAN, HERMOSA AND REDONDO BEACH.

Amalgamated Meatcutters and Butcher Workmen of N.A., Local No. 587, of Santa Monica, party of the first part, hereby agrees to place this UNION MARKET CARD in the place of business of the party of the second part, on the following terms:

NO. 1. The party of the second part agrees to employ only members in good standing with Local Union No. 587, Amalgamated Meatcutters and Butcher Workmen of N. A., or those who have declared their intentions of becoming same.

NO. 2. To display the Union Market Card in a conspicuous place.

NO. 3. That the Union Market Card is the property of said Local No. 587, Amalgamated Meatcutters and Butcher Workmen of N. A., and subject to withdrawal from the place of business of the party of the second part, if the terms of this agreement as outlined herein are violated by the party of the second part.

NO. 4. That all retail markets displaying the Union Market Card, which is the property of Local No. 587, will keep the hours as herein specified: The hours shall be as follows: From 8 a. m. to 6 p. m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday (with one uninterrupted hour off for lunch), and from 8 a. m. to 7 p. m. on Saturday or days preceding Holidays (with one uninterrupted hour off for lunch).

NO. 5. The maximum of 15 minutes shall be allowed for cleaning up after closing. The following days shall be recognized as Legal Holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Armistice Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. No deduction in pay for the specified Holidays.

NO. 6. That all wholesale markets displaying the Union Market Card, which is the property of Local No. 587, will keep the hours herein specified: For all wholesale men, nine hours per day with one uninterrupted hour off for lunch. No Sunday or Holiday work except during the following period: May 15th to September 15th, during which wholesale work may be done in the forenoon up to 12 noon. Any meatcutter working the half day on Sundays or Holidays during this period is to have off one full day during the week, with no deduction in weekly pay. No work to be done except the filling of restaurant or boat orders, during the half day Sunday or Holiday work.

NO. 7. The following minimum scale of wages shall be paid, and any employee at the date of entering into this agreement receiving more or enjoying better conditions than herein provided, shall suffer no loss as a result of this agreement:

Market Operators	\$40.00 per week
One Man Shops and Wholesale Men.....	\$37.50 per week
Journeyman	\$35.00 per week
All extra men	\$ 6.50 per day
All extra men on Saturdays or days preceding Holidays.....	\$ 7.00 per day
Apprentices, first year.....	\$18.00 per week
Apprentices, second year	\$22.50 per week
Apprentices, third year	\$27.50 per week

When less than full week is worked, extra pay rate applies.

Not more than one apprentice may be employed, except at the ratio of one apprentice to five journeymen.

All meatcutters to be supplied from Local No. 587, unless same cannot be supplied from Local No. 587.

NO. 9. Party of the second part agrees to furnish all linens and laundry of same, without cost to the employees.

NO. 10. In consideration of the signing of this agreement by the party of the second part, Local No. 587, Amalgamated Meatcutters and Butcher Workmen of N. A., party of the first part, hereby agrees:

1. To furnish men who will work to the best interests of the employer in every way just and lawful; to give honest and diligent service to the patrons of the employer's establishment; to do everything in their power for the betterment of the meat industry; and further agrees to expel from membership of Local No. 587, upon sufficient proof, any member found guilty of a dishonest act.

2. To use its influence with Organized Labor and its friends to patronize only places that display the Union Market Card.

NO. 11. This agreement to be in effect for a period of one year from September 7th, 1938, to September 7th, 1939.
